We have a plan to return to worship in person with social distancing, in addition to continuing the broadcast on the website/Facebook. Prelude will begin 10 minutes prior to our worship start time at 10:30 am Sundays, beginning Pentecost, May 31. Please join us in person as your comfort level allows.

- Face covering is required (you can bring your own, or one will be provided for you). Hand sanitizer is available in the narthex and sanctuary.
- 6-foot distances from sidewalk to sanctuary have been marked.
- Greet one another creatively without touching while maintaining social distance.
- Family units are to worship 6 feet from other family units in the sanctuary.
- We will be using every other pew (marked by a sign) as well as selected chairs along the back wall. Unusable pews have been roped off.
- The worship service will be abbreviated with no congregational singing. This will limit the spread of the virus.
- The fans will be off (dress accordingly).
- There will be no fellowship/coffee hour for the time being. Do not gather in that area.
- Social distancing means only one person in the restroom at a time. Vacant/occupied signs are posted on the doors of the 3 restrooms outside the sanctuary.
- Nursery/child care/preschool will not be provided.
- As always, do not come to the church if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID 19.
